Box Hill, Surrey

Woodland and open down with wonderful views.

Clandon Park, Surrey

Grand 18th- century Palladian mansion.

Claremont Landscape Garden, Surrey

One of the first and finest gardens of the English Landscape style.

Ham House and Garden, Surrey

Unique 17th- century house with sumptuous interiors, original collections and restored formal gardens.

Hatchlands Park, Surrey

18th- century mansion, with Adam interiors and collection of keyboard instruments, set in parkland.

Hindhead Commons and The Devil's Punch Bowl Café, Surrey

A swathe of unspoilt woodland valleys and heath, marking the gateway to the Surrey Hills.

The Homewood, Surrey

20th- century Modernist house and garden.

Leith Hill, Surrey

Woodland, parkland, farmland and open heath with Leith Hill Tower commanding extensive views.

Oakhurst Cottage, Surrey

Small 16th- century timber framed cottage.

Polesden Lacey, Surrey

Regency country house with renowned Edwardian interiors and gardens, set in beautiful downland countryside.

Reigate Fort, Surrey

19th- century defensive fort positioned on top of Reigate Hill, affording sweeping views across the Weald.

River Way and Godalming Navigations and Dapdune Wharf, Surrey

Tranquil waterway running for nearly 20 miles through the heart of Surrey

Shalford Mill, Surrey

18th- century watermill with well-preserved machinery.

Winkworth Arboretum, Surrey

Tranquil hillside woodland with sweeping views.

The Whitley Centre, Surrey

Countryside visitor and education centre.
