



Green Policy

At Jurys Inn Brighton we are committed to an environmental policy focusing on every possible means to reduce our carbon footprint whilst sustaining a reliable, efficient and professional business model.

We have a number of measures in place to assist us in operating a Green Hotel as detailed, but not limited to, the below

- We operate a strict recycling policy in every area of the hotel
- All our lighting in the hotel is low energy with presence detection
- We utilise numerous water conservation measures including rainwater harvesting, tap flow restrictors and water shut off valves
- In room energy saver boxes are fitted throughout
- 30 metres² Solar water heating and electricity generation panels are fitted on the roof
- Our BREEAM* rating is “excellent” is the highest achievable
- The building has a Building Energy Management System to assist in reducing unnecessary energy consumption
- Several nesting boxes for domestic birds are fitted to the sides of the building
- Public transport, walking and cycling information is available to both guests and staff and it is something that we actively encourage
- Our procedures minimise energy use and waste across all departments including recycling and reusing of office paper
- Energy awareness information is available in all guest bedrooms
- Our message is actively promoted to guests and staff alike
- Where possible we promote the use of Fair Trade and eco friendly products
- Use of hazardous and toxic materials is kept to an absolute minimum

We are actively pursuing a targeted 5% reduction in energy and water over the year throughout the hotel. In April 2009 we joined the Green Tourism Business Scheme (GTBS) as an indicator of our sustainable practices and aims.
